

## Updated Changes for Over-the-Counter Purchases

Good news! Your Discovery Benefits debit card may continue to be used to purchase over-the-counter drugs and medicines! These purchases must meet certain requirements before the debit card will be approved:

- Purchase must be made at a drug store, pharmacy, non-healthcare merchant that have pharmacies (Walgreens, Target, etc.) or mail/web based vendors that sell prescription drugs
- Prior to purchase:
  - A prescription for the medicine or drug must be presented (in any format) to the pharmacist
  - The over-the-counter medicine or drug is dispensed by the pharmacist and an Rx number is assigned
- The pharmacy or other vendor retains a record of the Rx number, the name of the purchaser (or the name of the person for whom the prescription applies), the date and the amount of the purchase
- All of these records must be available to the employer or its agent upon request

*Please note that the debit card system will not accept a charge for an over-the-counter medicine or drug unless an Rx number has been assigned.*

If the above requirements are met, the debit card transaction will be considered fully substantiated at the point-of-sale.
